DAY 01 – October 19 | Venice (Embark)

DAY 02 – October 20 | Venice

With your early morning arrival at Doge’s Palace, you’ll be able to marvel at the estate in total peace. Wander through a Venetian neighborhood and experience daily life in an authentic Venetian residential quarter. Later in the evening, cap the day off with a private once-in-a-lifetime experience at an after-hours lighting ceremony inside St. Mark’s Basilica without the crowds.

DAY 03 – October 21 | Venice, Mazzorbo (Burano)

Start your morning in one of two of the Veneto region's UNESCO World Heritage cities. Visit Vicenza and experience a captivating light & music show in the Teatro Olimpico Theatre, the oldest Italian Renaissance theatre in existence or tour the medieval city of Padua, the hub of learning and discovery in the 13th century. In the afternoon, you'll reboard the ship for scenic sailing across the lagoon as we head towards Mazzorbo and Burano.

A special Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner will be prepared for you this evening.

DAY 04 – October 22 | Mazzorbo, Burano, Chioggia

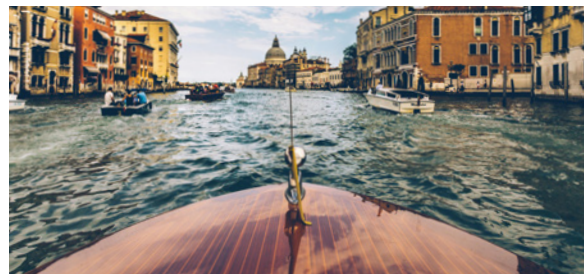
Spend the day exploring the northern lagoon of Venice and its captivating islands. Start with a visit to Torcello's famous basilica, once the greatest, most populous city on the lagoon. Only a handful of people live there now. Visit the famous basilica of Santa Maria Assunta, the oldest church on the lagoon with an art historian. The doors open early for us so you can see the stunning 11th century mosaic of the Last Judgement without the crowds. Next, stroll the agricultural island of Mazzorbo and the rainbow-hued island of Burano during your free time after lunch. Alternatively, you can take the afternoon to see the renowned glassblowing artisans of Murano at work.

DAY 05 – October 23 | Chioggia

Today, you'll travel to one of the most enticing islands in the Venice lagoon, the fishing village of Chioggia. Visit the greatest sites of coastal Chioggia, including the lively market (founded in the 5th century) which is open on the day we arrive. Instead, maybe you wish to board a genuine Adriatic wooden sailing boat, a bragozzo, to see the island from the

clear blue waters on the lagoon and visit the Tenuta Ca' Zen, a beautiful Venetian village with a fascinating story. Next, participate in tasting of local olive oil, wines, honey and cheeses. A bike tour of the island is also offered as well as a visit to Dominio di Bagnoli, one of the oldest wine producers in Europe for a private tasting.

DAY 06 – October 24 | Chioggia, Venice

This morning, join a sailing excursion where you'll explore the Po Delta where the Po River and the Adriatic Sea meet. Instead of sailing this morning, set off for the Euanean hills to discover one of Europe's most majestic castles, Castello Del Catajo.

DAY 07 – October 25 | Venice

Get an early morning start to see a side of Venice most tourists miss, the Dorsoduro, for a walking tour before moving on to meet a gondola artisan at work making Venice's iconic gondolas. Also, you may choose to do a "Do as the Locals Do" Venice walking tour. As your water taxi glides past narrow side canals and the Canal Grande, you'll arrive in style at the Rialto Bridge. The iconic stone arch bridge sits at the narrowest point of the Canal Grande and holds numerous shops and restaurants. You may decide to take a tour to see the Ca' Macana Atelier, the makers of the beautiful & intricate masks known in Venice. Perhaps you would like to take a lesson in rowing in the Venice lagoons.

A special Captain's Farewell Reception and Dinner will be prepared for you this evening.

DAY 08 – October 26 | Venice (Disembark)

Itinerary | Italy Pre-Cruise Land Tour

Day 01 – October 15 | Arrive Naples, Italy • Pompeii • Sorrento

Welcome to Naples, Italy! Meet your Tour Director upon arrival in Naples to board your coach to Pompeii for a guided walking tour of the excavations. Pompeii, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, was an ancient city that was buried under 13 to 20 ft. of volcanic ash and pumice in the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD. Largely preserved under the ash, the excavated city offers a unique snapshot of Roman life, frozen at the moment it was buried. It was a wealthy town, with a population of about 11,000, enjoying many fine public buildings and luxurious private houses with lavish decorations, furnishings and works of art which were well-preserved and seen today. Pompeii is still being excavated today. After the tour, enjoy some free time for lunch.

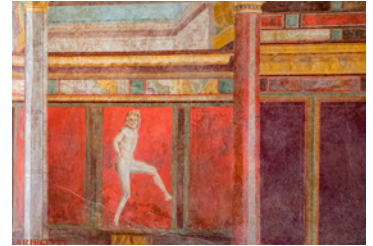
Continue to the seaside town of Sorrento, a fun town built on a line of Sea Cliffs. Spend a remarkable evening enjoying an authentic 3-course welcome dinner from the Campania region as you bask in the delightful Mediterranean atmosphere at one of the city's most beloved historical restaurants! (D)

Note: The group needs to arrive in the morning during the same arrival window (60-90 minutes) to utilize the included group transfer and Pompeii tour.

Day 02 – October 16 | Sorrento • Amalfi Coast Drive

Today, the most thrilling drive in Europe awaits as you drive the spectacular Amalfi Coast, another UNESCO World Heritage site. Hemmed in by high mountains, the coastal towns on this spectacular seaford stretch are unspoiled and stunning with its breathtaking panoramas. Stop in charming Positano for some free time and lunch on your own before returning to your hotel for an evening at your leisure. This magnificent adventure is an all-day excursion. (B)

Itinerary | Italy Pre-Cruise Land Tour



Day 03 – October 17 | Sorrento • Orvieto • Montecatini

Today, leave Sorrento and travel through Tuscan vistas of rolling hills, cypress trees, terraced vineyards, and charming villages. Stop in Orvieto, a medieval Umbrian city, with its world famous Duomo and the Saint Patrick's Well above the Paglia River Valley. This ancient town center is filled with narrow streets, beautiful churches, historic palaces and the mysterious maze of underground tunnels and caves. Your orientation tour includes the cathedral, the underground, San Brizio Chapel, free time and lunch on your own in the Piazza del Duomo.

Upon leaving Orvieto, drive through Tuscany to Montecatini, your home for the next 2 nights. This hillside town in the heart of Tuscany is perfectly situated between its massive city walls. A stroll down the well-preserved streets will have you stepping back in time, with its towers, medieval fortresses, and churches from before the XII century as well as delicious restaurants, cozy pubs, and busy town squares where you can enjoy the atmosphere of an authentic Tuscan town. It also has long been known for its 'healing' thermal waters since the time of the Romans. (B)

Day 04 – October 18 | Montecatini

Enjoy a morning guided walking tour of Montecatini including the funicular to Montecatini Alto. Enjoy free time to browse and have lunch on your own - or - The leaning Tower of Pisa and Basilica with free time and lunch on your own.

Today, travel to the Leaning Tower of Pisa and the beautiful Piazza del Doumo Cathedral next to the leaning tower, 2 more UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Return to your hotel for an afternoon at leisure.

Complete your magnificent tour with an authentic Italian cooking class in Tuscany and farewell dinner at the Villa Pandolfini Estate (or similar) in Tuscany to celebrate with fellow passengers your exciting journey. (B,D)

Day 05 – October 19 | Montecatini • Venice For Embarkation

Today, after breakfast, travel to your beautiful ship in Venice, the S.S. La Venezia. This is truly and unique and exciting pre-cruise tour. Bon Voyage! (B)
